Psalms 35:1-5; 27-28

¹Plead my cause, O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me.

²Take hold of shield and buckler, and stand up for mine help.

³ Draw out also the spear, and stop the way against them that persecute me: say unto my soul, I am thy salvation.

⁴ Let them be confounded and put to shame that seek after my soul: let them be turned back and brought to confusion that devise my hurt.

⁵ Let them be as chaff before the wind: and let the angel of the LORD chase them.

²⁷ Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

²⁸ And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness and of thy praise all the day long.

LESSON #1: Don't Accept Defeat

- Although David's enemies sought to kill him, he did not allow adversity to defeat him.
- Trust God despite what goes on around you

LESSON # 2: God Made The Provision

- God is working behind the scene, we need to do our due diligence with preparations
- Begin praising God in-advance

LESSON # 3: God Made The Promise

- David did not take vengeance in his on hands, but trusted that would keep His promise to be a protector
- •We need to know that God's promise to be our "everything" will never go void

LESSON # 4: God Has Given Us Paradise

- In versus 27 and 28, David stated that he will shout with "joy" and be glad in God's righteousness. We need to have the same attitude.
- We may sometimes have bad days here on earth, but know that our ultimate paradise is in heaven
