Pslams 1:1-6

1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

LESSON # 1: We Need To Be Consistent In Our Walk With God

❖ Psalm 1:1

1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

- Our walk with God should not sway because of worldly opinions by others
- There is a difference in being consistent in our walk with God and just going through the motion...our actions will yield godly results

LESSON # 2: Meditating on God's Word Allow Us To Focus More On Him

❖ Psalm 1:2-3

² But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

³ And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

- ❑ We need to eliminate distractions
- ❑ Time with God allows Him to give us true guidance in our lives
- ❑ Walking with God does not omit us from having difficult times, but it does allow us to bear fruit and have God's blessings

❖ Psalm 1:4-6

⁴ The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away.

⁵ Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

⁶ For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish
