Acts 17:10-16

¹⁰ And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews.

¹¹ These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

¹² Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few.

Acts 17:10-16 (Continued)

¹³ But when the Jews of Thessalonica had knowledge that the word of God was preached of Paul at Berea, they came thither also, and stirred up the people.

¹⁴ And then immediately the brethren sent away Paul to go as it were to the sea: but Silas and Timotheus abode there still.

¹⁵ And they that conducted Paul brought him unto Athens: and receiving a commandment unto Silas and Timotheus for to come to him with all speed, they departed.

Acts 17:10-16 (Continued)

¹⁶ Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry.

Three Reasons Why To Stand Bold:

- **1.** People need to hear the Word of God
- 2. Being deeply involved in the Word keeps us directly connected to God
- **3.** Our job as Christians is to compel others to Christ

LESSON #1: People Need To Hear The Word of God

*****There are people who are lost and need to know the Word

Misinterpretation of the Word is being taught by those who truly do not understand the Word

LESSON # 2: Being Deeply Involved In The Word Keeps Us Directly Connected To God

- In order for our message to be effective, we need to be one with God

- One's own opinion should not be taught. The Word should not ever be water downed nor should we take pieces out that fits our personal gain.
