

BRIEF OVERVIEW

Bethany Baptist Church, S.B.C. of Houston annually presents a minimum scholarship award of \$250 (maximum of \$2,000) to qualifying student-members pursuing higher education (college, university, or vocational school) through Bethany Scholarship Fund Award (BSFA). The BSFA was created and has been managed by the College Ministry Team since 1997.

All hopeful applicants must submit a completed scholarship application with all required materials by the published deadline. An ad hoc Scholarship Committee facilitates the screening and interview phases and rates the applicant to determine the scholarship award amount. Email correspondence will be sent to inform applicants of their status throughout the entire process. Award letters are presented the 2nd Sunday in June.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

THE APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a member of Bethany Baptist Church, S.B.C. of Houston and an active participant in, at least, two (2) church ministries, auxiliaries, or committees. (CHURCH MEMBERSHIP AND PARTICIPATION WILL BE VERIFIED.)
- Submit enrollment documentation and be in good standing each year they desire to be considered. (ENROLLMENT DOCUMENTATION INCLUDES OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL OR COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS, FEE RECEIPTS, ETC.)
- Submit a picture with each application. (PICTURE MAY BE DISPLAYED DURING WORSHIP SERVICE ON GRADUATION SUNDAY.)

- (First-time applicants) must supply a typed, double-spaced <u>250</u>-word essay. (SEE PAGE 2 FOR ESSAY TOPICS.)
- Must return the application and other required materials by the published deadline: APRIL 4th.
- Must be interviewed by the ad hoc Scholarship Committee. (AN INTERVIEW IS SCHEDULED ONCE AN APPLICANT HAS RETURNED THE COMPLETED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION BY THE PUBLISHED DEADLINE.)

UNDERGRADUATE & GRADUATE REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants pursuing higher education away from home must be active with a local church body or service organization. A letter of acknowledgement from the church or organization should be submitted with the scholarship application.
- Undergraduate applicants must be enrolled in full-time course studies; a minimum of twelve (12) semester credit hours.
- Graduate applicants will be processed on an individual basis.



ACCESS TO THE APPLICATION

Applicants may retrieve the BSFA application from the church website at www.bethany1925.com every March.

ESSAY TOPICS

FIRST-TIME APPLICANTS MUST CHOOSE ONE TOPIC AND SUBMIT YOUR ESSAY WITH THE APPLICATION.

- What are two negative life experiences that have helped you learn to trust the Lord Jesus Christ above all else?
